1) DATA PROTECTION ACT:

I DO / DO NOT consent to our details being stored on a computer database solely for the internal use of Ley Hill Cricket Club. (Please delete as necessary. If you do not complete this section it will be assumed you consent to your details being stored electronically.)

2) VIDEO EQUIPMENT:

It is the intention of the Ley Hill coaching team to occasionally make use of video equipment to photograph children in order to assist them in their coaching. To do so we require parental consent. LHCC will not permit these videos to be used outside of this purpose.

I DO / DO NOT consent to my child(ren) being videoed for coaching purposes.

3) UNDER 13s PLAYING IN SENIOR MATCHES:

ECB guidelines require specific permission from parents of U13 players to play in open age (adult) cricket matches. This would be based on a recommendation from the coaching staff as appropriate for the player's development.

Fee for Juniors aged 6 to 8 years (as at 1/9/09) attending practice sessions (<i>includes associated membership for parents</i>) – one child only	£35 (includes a free club shirt for <u>new</u> juniors.) Described as Junior Associate Membership.
Fee for Juniors aged 9 to 17 years (as at 1/9/09) attending practice sessions (<i>includes associated membership for parents</i>) – one child only	£40 (includes a free club shirt for <u>new</u> juniors.) Described as Associate Membership.
Additional siblings	£25 each (includes a free club shirt for <u>new</u> juniors)

The above rates include social membership (ie use of the club bar) for all non-playing parents. If however you wish to become more involved in the running of the club (ie have full voting rights; become a member of the club committee or become a club official, you can elect to pay the following:

Fee for all Juniors whose parents wish to have <i>Full Voting Rights as a club member</i> – one child only	£65 (includes a free club shirt for <u>new</u> juniors). Described as Full Associate Membership.
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In addition to the subs, we charge a match fee for each game of cricket which is played against another club. It is expected that ALL players will have their match fee ready to hand over at each game they play and the current rates are as follows:

All juniors playing in senior matches	£4 per game
All juniors playing in junior matches	£2 per game
